

**INSTRUCTIONS FOR NEWLY ADMITTED DEGREE FOUNDATION/JUPEB AND
CAMBRIDGE ADVANCED LEVEL STUDENTS FOR THE 2023/2024 ACADEMIC
SESSION**

A. RESUMPTION:

Registration for the **2023/2024** session begins on **Wednesday, September 20th, 2023**. All parents are hereby informed that there will be an interactive session on the institution premises on the resumption day.

B. Candidates are expected to come with the following for registration:

- Evidence of School Fees Payment
- Admission Letter
- Evidence of payment of the ₦10,500 (Application Fee) and ₦100,000 (Acceptance Fee)
- Photocopies and original of O' Level results
- Birth Certificate/Declaration of age
- Letter of Attestation from a reputable Nigerian or the parent
- Four (4) Recent passport photographs
- Subsidized Medical tests, Drug tests, and JUPEB Syllabus----~~₦~~20,000 (**TO BE PAID IN CASH**)
- All Science students must come with their Lab Coats with their **names boldly written** on it

C. ROOM ALLOCATION:

Allocation to rooms shall be done after the registration exercise and on a first come – first serve basis. A two-man room will attract additional fees of **₦40,000** and there are limited spaces for such.

D. HALLS OF RESIDENCE REQUIREMENTS

G. MOVEMENT OF STUDENTS

For security reasons, the school operates a very strict policy on the movement of students in and out of school and around the city.
